There are three types of person-centered plans you will commonly see:

- · housing focused person-centered plans,
- · coordinated services and supports plans,
- · coordinated care plans,

Person-centered plans are created by housing consultants, case managers, or senior care coordinators. While Transition/Sustaining providers do not create person-centered plans ALL Housing Stabilization Services must be person-centered. Transition and sustaining providers will work with the person to identify how the person-centered plan will be

implemented.

Coordinated Services and Supports Plan (CSSP) is a person-centered process that helps waiver case managers to determine the needs, wants and preferences of a person in relation to benefits and services they may be able to use. Case managers use the coordinated services and supports plan to discover more about a person in relation to the services they are eligible for and what types of housing may work best for them.

If someone has a Senior Care Coordinator, they will have a coordinated care plan. The look of this plan may vary based on what type of health plan the person is on.

These will have medical and disability information. These plans are created by Medicare providers for people that are usually 65 or older.

There is not one uniform coordinated care plan. Instead it differs depending on the case manager.

2.7 Housing Services Plans

Housing Services Plans

Transition/Sustaining providers will use the personcentered plans to create their own specific housing services plan.

Person-centered plans are created by many different people and then are taken by Transition providers to make a housing services plan. The housing services plan is used by you, the Transition provider, to figure out how to get each recipient into a stable home by meeting their budget, needs, wants and accessibility requirements.

There is not a specific form for housing service plans, instead they are a living document that is always being updated based on what housing will work best for the people served.

My Vault provides pathways and securely stores important files, documents, and contacts which can be shared. My Vault has the capacity to save information that a person or provider may need to access such as a person-centered plan or eligibility documentation.

People may give you access to their vaults. You can walk through their pathways together and review, revise, delete or add information to their pathways.

You can use HB101 to store and share person-centered plans. You can also use the HB101 pathways to create a housing services plan.


Reviewing a Person-Centered Plan

Housing stabilization services recipients will have created a person-centered plan when they were deemed eligible for the program. Regardless of what type of person-centered plan they have, reviewing their plans ensures everything is up to date, accurate, and decided by the recipient.

When reviewing person-centered plans think a about how it applies to housing options. Use this information to create a housing services plan.

Housing services plans allow for providers to put together the necessary housing needs, wants, accessibility requirements, and budgets.

3.3 Reviewing Recipient's Needs

Reviewing Recipient's Needs

If the recipient **does have** a housing focused person-centered plan, go through it and begin to think of how the information can be used to find the recipient housing. Even think of what has not been answered about their housing needs and wants and ask the recipient those unanswered questions.

If the recipient **does not have** a housing focused person-centered plan, look to see what information is already in the alternate person-centered plan that can be used to focus on the recipient's housing needs. Then ask the recipient questions that can fill in any gaps in information about themselves and their potential housing.



The Minnesota Department of Human Services has developed Foundational Service Practices as a guide in working with people experiencing homelessness. They allow for you as a provider to understand the recipients of the program and help those who are experiencing homelessness.

3.5 Foundational Service Practices Guidelines

Follow these guidelines. Know the housing status of people you work with Actively reach out to people experiencing homelessness. Limit requirements for in-person appointments at a particular location or office. Assist with the process of gathering required verifications or documentation. Allow for multiple methods to communicate about benefits and services.
